This release was caused by a failure in the stuffing box. Vacuum trucks were dispatched to recover any standing fluid and dispose of at an NMOCD approved facility.

All fluid stayed on location and impacted an area approximately 36'x14'. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
