Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

The fire is believed to have started in the main production heater treater and spread to the other heaters and separators. No tanks were involved. Flowlines were also destroyed. There was a release of approximate 350 bbls of liquid (combination of oil and water) but there is no way for us to determine the amounts of each as the fluid burned during the fire.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

Soil samples have been taken. Approximately 2' of material will be removed and hauled to disposal. Once the material has been removed, the pad will be rebuilt with a 20 mil liner installed. The remaining impact will be left in place, and will be addressed after the battery has been rebuilt.
