Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
This spill was caused fiberglass piping. Vacuum trucks were dispatched to recover standing fluid and dispose of at an NMOCD approved facility. Fiberglass was replaced with poly piping.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The release occurred inside a lined facility, however approximately 36 bbls carried over the dike on to the location and into the pasture. Concho will have the spill site sampled to delineate any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
