The System may be upgraded to a higher pressure but still tested to the working pressure listed in the table above. Pipe rams will be operationally checked each 24 hour period. Blind rams will be operationally checked on each trip out of the hole. These checks will be noted on the daily tour sheets. Wellhead will be installed by FMC's representatives.
