Perhaps as early as July 20, Oxy plans to spud the first of a series of Federal wells in Eddy County. Oxy has asked Hicks Consultants to design and permit a solids disposal pit that will accept the cuttings from a closed loop system. The pit will hold some liquids for short periods (days not weeks).

The schedule for drilling is, more or less, presented below and the attached maps show the locations with the exception of the Peaches wells. We need to know if BLM could act on a Sundry notice to change from closed loop to pits at the Cypress 34 Fed 10H soon enough to allow for the construction of the pit beginning about July 10.

I would like to meet with you next week for about 30 minutes to explain this concept of on-site management of solids and recycling of drilling fluids. Having a karst specialist at this meeting would be good as the Ivore and Misty lie at the edge of high/moderate karst. We might also talk about the Peaches wells at this time.

If we could have this meeting next Thursday at a time of your choice, I can have the permit application and sundry ready to present. A Friday moming meeting can also work.

I will call you both later today to see if we can make this happen.
