Ladies & Gentlemen:

Read & Stevens has received your letter dated October 31, 2005 concerning disposing of water in the subject well at an injection pressure of 780 psi. Please be advised that in order to correct the situation on the existing well, three things will be done.

- 1. A surfactant will be added to the produced water disposal stream to reduce surface tension in an attempt to lower injection pressure.
- 2. The injection pump will be crippled so that it can run at a slower rate for a longer period of time.
- 3. A pressure limiting device will be installed at the wellhead to shut the injection pump off when a predetermined pressure is reached.

The Artesia OCD office will be notified at least 48 hrs prior to the date and time that the well will be placed back on injection with the aforementioned corrective actions. If you have any questions, please advise.
