

Prior Title Opinion

Copy of our Original Drilling Title Opinion dated April 19, 2004, addressed to SDX Resources, Inc., covering captioned land, based upon the prior title opinion, examination of records and instruments described therein, which taken together cover the federal records from inception of the records to February 28, 2004 at 8:00 a.m. and the county records from inception of the records to February 26, 2004 at 8:00 a.m.

Examination of the Records




