The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District II office (OCD) is in receipt of a form C-141 marked Initial and Final Report, reporting a release of produced fluids that occurred at the above referenced location on 10/16/2005. The reported fluid released was produced water and the reported release volume was 35 barrels.

The C-141 submitted has the box checked indicating immediate notice was "not required". As per the reporting requirements of Rule 116, "an unauthorized release of a volume, excluding natural gas, in excess of 25 barrels" is considered a Major Release and requires immediate verbal notification and timely written notice. Immediate verbal notice is described as being "within twenty-four (24) hours of discovery" and timely written notice described as being "within fifteen (15) days".

At this time, this information is being provided as notification of reporting requirements for any releases that may occur in the future. Failure to notify as specified in Rule 116 is a violation of NMOCD Rules and Regulations.

The C-141 submitted is accepted with the following stipulations:

1. Remove or remediate any contaminated materials that may be present from this release.
2. Notify the contact person listed below with intent for disposition of contaminated materials.
