A 20 mil synthetic liner will be placed over the drilling pit contents with a minimum of a 3' over-lap of the drilling pit area. The drilling pit will then be backfilled to grade using a minimum of 3' of clean soil or like material. Mud seed will be applied in the proper seed mixture. A one call and 48 hour notice will be provided to the Oil Conservation Division before pit closure actions begin.

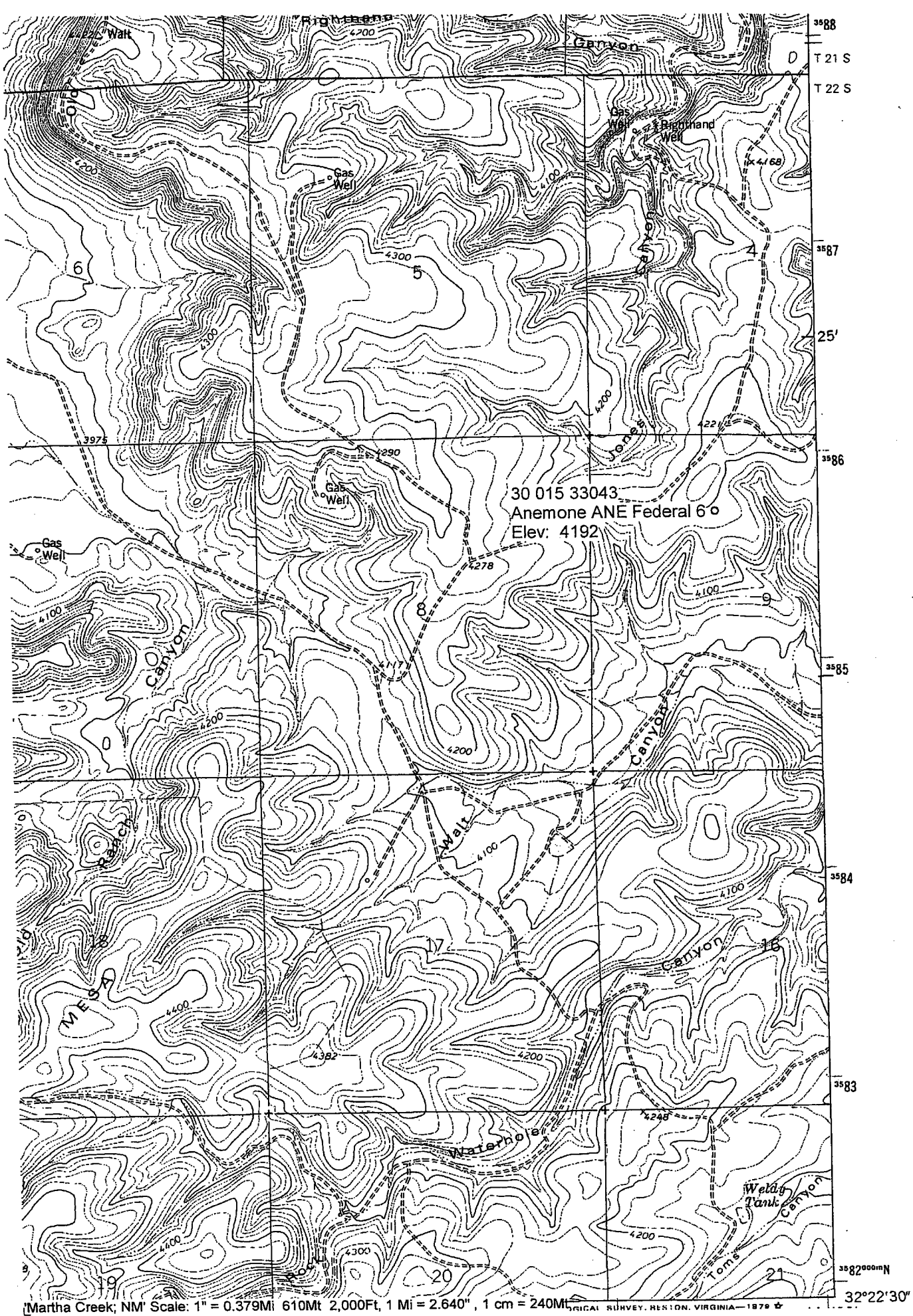
