RE: Administrative application (Division Administrative Application Reference No. pSEM0-534731570) for EOG Resources, Inc.'s proposed Danube "14" Fed. Com. Well No. 2H (API No. 30-015-34494) to be directional drilled as a horizontal well within the Undesignated Northeast Collins Ranch-Wolfcamp Gas Pool (96623) from a surface location 230 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the East line (Unit P) of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 24 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, to a targeted bottomhole location, or end point, 660 feet from the North line and 760 feet from the East line (Unit A) of Section 14.
