

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Was checking wells and spotted a 3" poly leaking from where pipe was fused together. Leak was caused by age and heat exposure, put clamp to stop it from leaking while it got repaired, clam did not hold so had to shut in well. Sprayed about a 15'x15' spot west of wellhead.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.

The contaminated soil was removed from the site and properly disposed of at a NMOCD approved facility. The excavation was backfilled with clean, imported soil to ground surface and contoured to the surrounding area.
