Vacuum trucks were immediately dispatched to recover standing fluid and the contaminated gravel has been replaced with fresh gravel. Concho will have the spill site inspected for any possible contamination from the release and we will present a remediation work plan to the NMOCD for approval prior to any significant remediation work.
