The volume of the release caused by the below grade flow line was unknown. Evaluation is ongoing to determine if the release was in such quantity as may with reasonable probability be detrimental to water or exceed the standards in Subsections A and B or C of 19.15.30.9 NMAC. Lime Rock will provide the results of the ongoing investigations to OCD and, if necessary, a remediation plan consistent with Part 29.
