

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

This leak was caused by a 3-inch steel line from the heater treater water leg to the inlet for water tanks failing. Inlet to water tank has been repaired. All fluid was contained within above ground Falcon lined containment.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

All fluid was recovered via vacuum truck from Falcon lined containment. Pictures have been included of cleaned containment. C141 has been marked as Initial and Final since all fluids were recovered.
