4/9/06 Resumed drilling at 6:00 AM. Set 13-3/8" 48# casing at 511'. Cemented with 350 sx 35:65:6 Poz "C" + .25#/sx Cellophane flakes + 5#/sx Gilsonite (yld 1.98, wt 12.6). Tailed in with 200 sx "C" + 2% CaCl2 (yld 6.36, wt 14.8). Cement circulated to surface. Tested casing to 600 psi for 30 min. WOC 31 hrs and 15 min. Reduced hole to 11" and resumed drilling.
