Dear Mr. Bruce:


Due to inadvertence the description of the 280-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit for the Kennedy Farms-Morrow Gas Pool (79520) in Eddy County, New Mexico, approved by Division Administrative Order NSP-1840, dated January 17, 2001, is incorrect and shall therefore be amended at this time to read in its entirety as follows:

The corrections set forth in this order shall be entered retroactively as of January 17, 2001; all other provisions of Division Administrative Order NSP-1840 shall remain in full force and effect until further notice.

Dear Mr. Bruce:

Reference is made to the following: (i) your application on behalf of the operator Devon S&S Operating, Inc. ("Devon") dated December 18, 2000; and (ii) the records of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division in Santa Fe ("Division"): all concerning Devon's request for the formation of the following described non-standard 280-acre gas spacing and production unit to be applicable to any and all formations and/or pools from the surface to the base of the Morrow formation that are developed on 280-acre spacing and governed under the provisions of Division Rule 104 C (2), which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the Kennedy Farms-Morrow Gas Pool.

EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, NMPM
Section 16 N/2 SW/4 and SE/4.

This unit is to be dedicated to Devon's proposed Veranda "16" State Comm. Well No. 1 to be drilled at a standard gas well location pursuant to Division Rule 104 C (2) (a) 660 feet from the South and East lines (Unit P) of Section 16.

This application has been duly filed under the provisions of Division Rule 104 D (2), revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Division Rule 104 D (2) (b), the above-described 280-acre non-standard gas spacing and production unit is hereby approved. Further, jurisdiction is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
