Yates is in receipt of your letter dated June 9, 2006 requesting status of this release.

Background and Actions Taken: The de-hy unit leaked glycol into the concrete containment vessel and spilled over the vessel affecting an approximate 25' X 15' area directly north of the de-hy unit. The containment vessel was washed out and the fluids were removed with a vacuum truck. The soils impacted by the over-spill were immediately excavated to insure all affected soils were removed. Clean fill was brought in to replace excavated materials and graded. The contaminated soil was removed to an approved NMOCD commercial disposal site.

Due to the quick response of Yates personnel and the presence of low permeable sediments, we do not believe this release will have a significant impact. Yates proposes that no additional actions are necessary and requests NMOCD approval to close the site.

Attached is a Final Report C-141. Your consideration to this request for closure is appreciated.
