In accordance with New Mexico Administrative Code ("NMAC"), please find written documentation and the state required Form C-141 for a discharge which occurred at the above referenced on April 28, 2006.

Approximately fifteen (15) barrels of produced water and zero (0) barrels of condensate/oil were released due to a leak in the flowline resultant from external corrosion. The impacted area was immediate to the flowline and no waters of the state and/or US were affected. Zero (0) barrels of produced water were recovered. The estimated surface area impact is one-thousand (1000) square feet and approximately 0.25 inch of vertical soil impact occurred. This affected area will be fertilized and tilled to mix and promote bioremediation of the impacted soil.

Preventative action for re-occurrence will involve replacement of this flowline with a heavier gauge tubular.
