Site LA 138,549 is within a quarter-mile radius of the project area. Sites LA 102,897, LA 132,725, and LA 132,540 are within a one-mile radius of the project area.

b. Description of Undertaking: The Eagle "35-H" Federal Number 15 Alternate well location is staked in Section 35, T.17-S, R.27-E. The impact area for the well location is 400 ft X 400 ft. The survey area for the proposed well location is 600 ft by 600 ft; however, Southern New Mexico Archaeological Services, Inc., recently surveyed a 500 ft by 500 ft area within the current 600 ft by 600 ft survey area. Therefore, a 100 ft by 600 ft area, and a 100 ft by 500 ft area was surveyed. The impact area for the proposed alternate well location is 400 ft by 400 ft.

c. Environmental Setting (NCRS soil designation: vegetative community; elevation; etc.): The project area is situated on a plain with an approximate 3' slope. Elevation ranges from around 3,572 ft to 3,610 ft above msl. Sediment is a shallow, light brown, fine, loose, calcareous silty/sandy loam, intermixed with caliche pebbles to cobbles, that overlies gypsiferous rocks. The immediate area is used for grazing cattle and oil production. An existing two-track lease road truncates the project area in east/west direction. Modern trash, probably related to oilfield activities is scattered throughout the project area. The vegetative community is characterized by a desert grassland assemblage. Flora includes Creosote, Scorpionweed, and various species of grass and succulents.

d. Field Methods (transect intervals; crew size; time in field, etc.): The pedestrian survey was conducted by walking transects spaced at 15 m intervals across the survey area. Time spent in the field was 2 hrs.

e. Artifacts Collected?

No

17. Cultural Resource Findings: One isolated occurrences (IO-1) was encountered.

a. Location/Identification of Each Resource: IO-1 was recorded during the previous survey of the originally proposed Eagle "35H" Federal Number 15 well location (SNMAS-03NM-1093). The isolated occurrence was relocated. IO-1 is a primary flake made of brown quartzite. The flake measures 46 mm X 31 mm X 6 mm. The location is 571038E/3628439N. The previous GPS reading of IO-1 is 571033N/3628438E, a 5 m N/S and 1 m E/W discrepancy from the previous reading (SNMAS-03NM-1093). IO-2, found during the previous survey, could not be relocated. It is assumed that alluvial deposition has buried the artifact.

b. Evaluation of Significance of Each Resource: The research potential for IO-1 has been exhausted.

18. Management Summary (Recommendations): During the current survey, one isolated occurrence was encountered, recorded, and research potential exhausted in the field. Therefore, **archaeological clearance is recommended** for the proposed Eagle "35H" Federal Number 15 Alternate well location and access road, located in Section 35, T.17S, R.27E. **with no stipulations.**
