- Upon removal of impacted materials, confirmation samples are to be obtained and delivered to an OCD approved laboratory for analyses along with proper chain of custody documentation. Notify the OCD 48 hours prior to obtaining confirmation samples.
- Upon satisfactory completion of project, a closure report outlining steps taken to remediate sites along with analytical data is to be submitted to the OCD.
- Project is to be completed and closure report submitted no later than August 6, 2007,
- All contact and correspondence pertaining to these remediation projects is to be made to the OCD District 2 office in Artesia, New Mexico.

Please be advised that this approval does not relieve Tempo Energy Inc. of liability should their operations have failed to properly investigate and remediate contamination that pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment.
