If a Watercourse was Impacted, Describe Fully*

The tank battery pad is located on the north side of one of the tributaries of the "Seven Rivers" drainage system. Two locations on the north periphery of the channel were moderately impacted by released produced water; one off the SW corner of the pad; and one across a caliche road west of the pad.

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken. *

Lightning strike on two 500-bbl produced water storage tanks (fiberglass). Each tank contained approximately 50-bbl at the time of the strike. Vacuum truck recovered 100-bbl of water, however, it was a mixture of rain water, fire fighting water and released water.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken. *

Three areas were affected. The immediate area of the tanks is approximately 70' X 100' (7000 ft²); the affected area south of the pad is 80' X 20' (1600 -ft²) and; the affected area southwest is 90' X 50' (4500-ft²). Hungry Horse, LLC, Hobbs, NM contracted to perform site restoration.

The New Mexico Oil Conservation Division District 2 Office (OCD) is in receipt of a Site Remediation Plan (plan) formulated by your agent, Hungry Horse, LLC. The plan outlines methods proposed to be used to remediate contamination present at the above referenced site due to a lightning strike that occurred on 5/2/07. The plan is approved with the following stipulations:

- Notify the OCD 24 hours prior to commencement of activities. (The OCD understands some immediate response actions have already been performed).
- Notify the OCD 24 hours prior to obtaining samples where analyses of samples obtained are to be submitted to the OCD.
- Include a Final Report C-141 as part of the final closure documentation as indicated in the plan.
- Project is to be completed and closure documentation submitted to the OCD no later than August 13, 2007.

Please be advised that OCD approval of this plan does not relieve Mewbourne Oil Company of liability should their operations have failed to adequately investigate and remediate contamination that pose a threat to ground water, surface water, human health or the environment. In addition, OCD approval of this plan does not relieve Mewbourne Oil Company of responsibility for compliance with any other federal, state, local laws and or regulations.
