Explanation of Details

Since approval was granted to flare gas from the subject well by Sundry Notice on May 18, 2007, the following events have transpired:

- 1) Automatic igniter installed on vent line.
- 2) Meter run installed on vent line to continuously measure gas volume being flared.
- 3) Gas and water samples taken to evaluate feasibility of treating gas for removal of H₂S.
- 4) Pipeline ROW staked and surveyed.
- 5) Archeological evaluation of proposed pipeline ROW.
- 6) Started producing well with gas being flared on May 23, 2007. Since this time the well has averaged 120 BOPD, 90 BWPD and estimated 70 MCFD (charts are currently being integrated).

An extension to continue to flare the gas thru 9/11/07 is requested primarily for the following reasons:

- 1) To allow time for a proper analysis of samples obtained since the well began producing on May 23, 2007 to determine the feasibility of removing the H₂S from the gas stream.
- 2) Should it be feasible to treat the gas, time will be needed to install the proper equipment and lay a pipeline to the nearest sales point (approx ½ mile).
- 3) If the gas can not be treated, a analysis of such will be submitted immediately and a evaluation justifying same will be submitted.
