

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The estimated release was contained within the dike area. The area inside the dike is lined. There was a good amount of rainwater standing inside the dike, as there was a large volume of rain in the area for the three days prior to the release. A vacuum truck was called in and removed all fluid possible. No produced oil was recovered. The contaminated gravel (floor inside the dike) was removed by Dansur LLC. and the liner was washed with a hot oiler. E.D. Walton Construction Co., Inc. disposed of the gravel at Controlled Recovery, Inc. Clean gravel was brought in and spread. No further remediation is anticipated.
