

Re: Administrative application (administrative application reference to pKRVQ-317428168) for an exception to Division Rule 104.B (1), revised by Division Order No. R-11231, issued by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Case No. 12119 on August 12, 1999, for Marbob Energy Corporation's proposed Lee Federal Well No. 5 (API No. 30-015-30500) to be drilled at an unorthodox Paddock oil well location 1400 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, within a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit comprising the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 20.

Dear Mr. Chumbley:

In reviewing the subject application at face value and assuming no other factors, it would appear that there are many other locations within the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 20 that meet the set back requirements while avoiding the "archeological site."

Your request is for an unorthodox location in the Loco Hills-Paddock Pool (96718). The proposed location is approximately three miles east of this pool.

Also, I am uncertain who and what was notified. You stated in your application "the only affected party was notified of this application via certified mail"; however, I do not know who the affected party is [see Division Rule 104.F (3)] or what they are [see Division Rule 1207.A (2) (a)].

The conservation rules in all oil and gas producing states governing well spacing and the placement of these wells within such drilling tracts/spacing units have been enacted to promote the orderly development of that states valuable oil and gas resources by preventing waste, protecting correlative rights, and preventing the drilling of unnecessary wells. It is very easy to get into a mode of thinking that considers these rules as minor inconveniences and applications for exceptions as "open and shut" issues.

Your application for the subject unorthodox oil well location, which is unnecessary and unwarranted at this time, is deemed incomplete and is therefore **denied**.
