- 1. As per Premier's work plan, all soil and caliche was removed from accident site which appeared stained by oil spill
- 2. Furthermore, all soil to a depth of 8"-12" was removed from the contaminated region so that a 5 PPM or less could be attained as showed by our pre-removal sampling.
- 3. The Oil Conservation was notifed and Jerry Guy did not witness but gave verbal approval of the post removal soil sampling. These samples showed that the remaining soil was 5 PPM or less, thus achieving our goal.
- 4. By Mr. Guy's approval, the location was repaired by filling in with dirt and caliche.
