Final Remediation Report

1. As per Premier's work plan, all soil and caliche was removed from accident site which appeared stained by oil spill
2. Furthermore, all soil to a depth of 8"-12" was removed from the contaminated region so that a 5 PPM or less could be attained as showed by our pre-removal sampling.
3. The Oil Conservation was notified and Jerry Guy did not witness but gave verbal approval of the post removal soil sampling. These samples showed that the remaining soil was 5 PPM or less, thus achieving our goal.
4. By Mr. Guy's approval, the location was repaired by filling in with dirt and caliche.
