With consideration given to setting four (4) strings of casing on the above captioned well, and in follow up to a conversation with Wesley Ingram of the BLM on 8/24/2007, BEPCO, L.P., respectfully requests to test the 20" diverter BOP and 20" casing string to 1,000 psi using the rig pumps.

The original permitted testing plan did not include the use of the 20" diverter system.

Full BOP/BOPE test to be performed prior to drilling out of 13 3/8" casing.
