
Ladies and Gentlemen:

On September 19, 2007, Bureau of Land Management (BLM) completed a field examination of the abandoned Rocky Arroyo Federal 8 No. 1 well, located 1980' FSL and 1977' FEL in Section 8, T. 22 S., R. 22 E., Eddy County, New Mexico.

All final abandonment requirements have been met except for vegetative growth (20%) established evenly across the location. BLM will continue to monitor the surface restoration of this abandoned well site. All final abandonment requirements will have been met when BLM is confident that the disturbed surfaces are capable of being restored to a condition similar to their original state.
