



HYDROGEN SULFIDE PUBLIC PROTECTION PLAN

The purpose of this plan is to safeguard the lives of the public and company personnel in the event of a component failure or natural disaster while oil and gas production operations are in progress.

A copy of this plan shall be available at the Burch Keely Central Tank Battery and Burch Keely Satellite E Battery as well as all the satellites.

I. Responsibilities and Duties of Key Personnel

The Foreman shall be responsible for overall oil and gas operations, on-site safety, training programs, and for implementing the procedures contained in this plan. In his absence the Assistant Foreman is in charge.

II. Emergency Call-out Procedures

During normal operations, the unit is controlled by a central alarm that monitors all batteries and satellites. In the event of an H₂S emergency, Nova Monitoring Systems, Inc. will immediately contact Marbob personnel. In order, persons contacted are as follows:

The following information is to be given to all persons contacted:

- 1. Nature of emergency, especially noting the presence of H_2S and concentrations of any H_2S .
- 2. Whether the emergency is under control or not.
- 3. Estimated flow rate of hazardous gas.
- 4. Whether hazardous gas is being flared.
- 5. Wind direction and velocity
- 6. Casualties and damage.
