On November 27, 2007 Talon/LPE will drill to a depth of 70' and install a temporary monitoring well to establish that ground water is at a depth greater than 50'. Talon/LPE will let the well set for 72 hours before testing with a water level meter. If water is encountered Talon/LPE will sample the water for TDS and if water is not encountered Yates Petroleum will request that this site be changed from a site ranking of 20 to a site ranking of 10.
