Samples are to be obtained from pit area and analysis submitted to NMOCD prior to back filling. Notify NMOCD 24 hours prior to obtaining samples.

If burial trench is to be constructed in the pit area, samples are to be obtained from that area and analyses submitted to NMOCD prior to lining the pit, but after contaminated soils have been excavated from trench area.

Notify NMOCD 24 hours prior to beginning closure.

If pit is situated in an agricultural area pit contents must be hauled to an NMOCD approved disposal area.

Pits must be closed within 6 months of the date production casing is set.
