Well was completed 2/22/05. Drilling pit is still open and full of solids/liquids. Additionally, pit liner is breached in several location, violation of Rule 50. Operator needs to submit C-144 for pit closure approval to OCD District II office and close drilling pit in accordance to OCD guidelines no later than 1/11/2008. Analytical data must be proved to OCD prior to backfilling pit. Photos
