Thank you for taking the time to visit with me concerning the TREX (Texas ReExploration Operating), - Plains #9-29 and the issue of storing oil contaminated soil on site within the tank battery berm.

In review.

The bermed area within the tank battery berm was only for temporary storage of the contaminated soil which had been removed from around wellheads. A place was needed to store the soil until a rolloff box for disposal could be delivered. We are in the process of a voluntary clean up of this field since buying the the field a little over a year ago. Phil Hawkins has visited some of our locations on this lease and is aware of our clean up efforts. The clean up is for historic issues TREX inherited when purchasing the lease.
