The BLM is objecting to the conversion of this well to an injection well for the following reason:

1. The proposed injection interval is approximately 30 feet above the top of the Capitan Reef, with no confining layer between the injection zone and the Reef. If approved the injected fluid would migrate downward and contaminate the Capitan Aquifer.
