
Dear Mr. Haden:

We have considered your request, set forth in your April 13, 2010 letter, that Intrepid Potash – New Mexico LLC ("Intrepid") waive any objection to the drilling of the above-referenced well.

As we have previously indicated, the proposed well is within the Potash Area defined under Order No. R-111-P and within a ¼ mile buffer of Intrepid's Life of Mine Reserve ("LMR") as submitted to the New Mexico State Land Office under that order.

Despite all of the foregoing, and recognizing that Intrepid has the absolute right under Order No. R-111-P to withhold its consent to the drilling of your proposed well, Intrepid will and hereby does waive any objection to the drilling of the well. By its non-objection, Intrepid does not agree to or assume the risks of any release of oil or gas or other substance from the Parkway "26" State Com No. 3H well into the environment, including into underground mine workings, arising out of or attributable to Mewbourne's drilling, operation, plugging and abandoning of the Parkway "26" State Com No. 3H well.

Please keep in mind Intrepid's reasonable and good faith willingness to work with Mewbourne to enable the drilling of this well the next time you are in a group of oil and gas companies inclined to denigrate and frustrate Intrepid's continuing efforts to mine the nation's only strategic potash reserve to provide needed fertilizer to grow the crops to feed this country.
