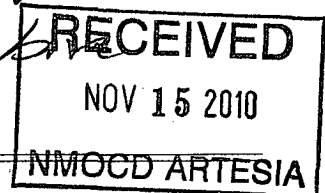
10/7/10: MIRU Luck Well Service. POOH w/ rods & pump. Secure well to set CIBP.
