The released exited the containment wall of the battery and entered the field to the west of the battery. From there the natural contour of the land channeled the release into a draw where it traveled approximately half a mile before coming to a stop. This draw feeds into the Dry Lake Playa.

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The release is a result of a tank release. Remedial action and delineation will occur pending an archeological site survey along with approval from BLM.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
