Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used and results obtained.
A 25 sack cement plug was spotted from 1199 feet to 900 feet; shot at 866 feet;
4 1/2 inch casing was pulled; a 10 sack plug was spotted at 250 feet and a 15 sack
plug was set at the surface. The hole was loaded with heavy mud prior to plug-
ging. This work was done May 7 and 8, 1961. Following completion of the
actual plugging, tanks and equipment were removed from the site, pits were
filled, the location was cleaned up, and a 4 inch steel marker was set which
extends at least four feet above mean ground level.
