### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was spudded March 31, 1950. 13-3/8" casing was set at 30 feet with 20 sack of cement. The well was drilled to 402 feet where lost circulation was encountered. The rig was moved 10 feet south in order to drill a new hole large enough to set 13-3/8" casing at about 500 feet in order to case off the lost circulation zone. Well No. 3 has not been plugged (See below). 1570FSL
