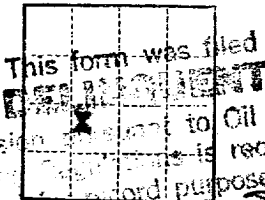

We desire approval to drill Jackson 22-B to approximately 6,800 to 7,200 feet to test the Aho. We propose to set 1,600 feet of new 8-5/8" 24#, cementing to surface and approximately 7,200 feet of 4-1/2" 11.60#, all J-55, cementing to base of 8-5/8". The well will be drilled with rotary, the contractor being Great Western Drilling Company, Midland, Texas

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

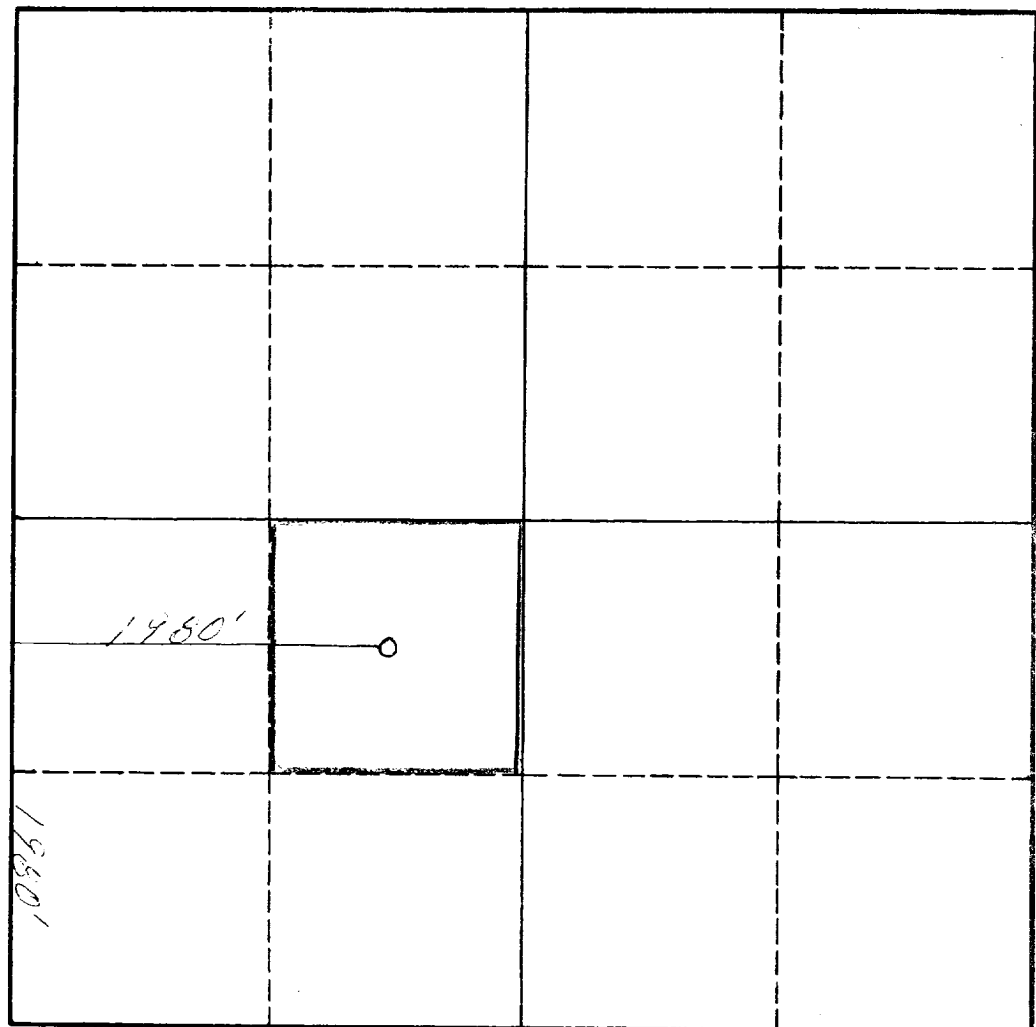

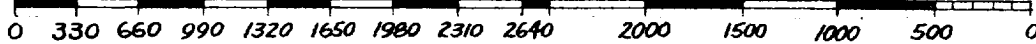
