DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

587 feet of 5" casing was set and cemented by Halliburton Nov. 9th with 50 sax cement. It was allowed to set 48 hours and plug was drilled and hole tested for water with bailer. However, no water was found, and no water had been encountered at that depth. Drilling was then resumed.
