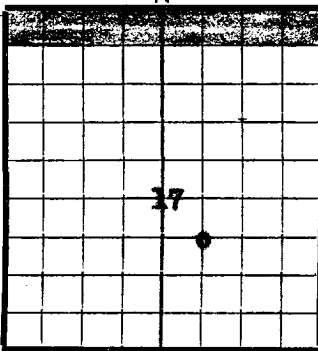

We propose to drill well with drilling equipment as follows: Cable Tools

20' of 55# 10", 550' of 52# 8-5/8", and 2900' of 22# 7" Casings

The status of a bond for this well in conformance with Rule 39 of the General Rules and Regulations of the Commission is as follows: \$5000.00 Bond will be in effect at commencement of well.

We propose to use the following strings of casing and to land or cement them as indicated:

Table with 7 columns: SIZE OF HOLE, SIZE OF CASING, WEIGHT PER FOOT, NEW OR SECOND HAND, DEPTH, LANDED OR CEMENTED, SACKS CEMENT. It details three casing strings: 12-1/2" hole with 10" casing (20' depth, cemented), 9-5/8" hole with 8-5/8" casing (550' depth, cemented), and 8-5/8" hole with 7" OD casing (2900' depth, cemented).

If changes in the above plan become advisable we will notify you before cementing or landing casing. We estimate that the first productive oil or gas sand should occur at a depth of about 2850 - 3480 feet.
