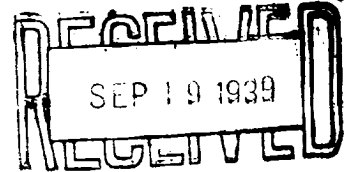

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After setting 2537 feet of 7" O.D. 20 lb. new seamless pipe with 3 tons of clay and 100 sacks of cement, letting same set 72 hours, the hole was bailed dry--cement plug drilled out and hole bailed dry again--let hole set one hour and re-bailed, encountered no water. Resumed drilling operations.
