On June 1, 1949, well was temporarily abandoned at total depth of 3997'. Hole was filled with mud laden fluid. 7" casing pulled. Cement plugs set at 2170-2200 and 2200-2250. Hole filled to top with mud laden fluid and ball plug put in top of 2 1/8" casing. The 2 1/8" casing was left in hole. Location marked according to U. S. G. S. instructions, and location cleaned up. Shank pit filled, etc. The method of plugging detailed herein is in compliance with instructions given our field superintendent, Mr. Charlesworth, by Mr. Frost.
