This well was drilled and temporarily abandoned in 1949, it was not considered to be a commercial producer at the time it was drilled. Results of the fracture treatments in the field indicated that that the well would make a paying one when fractured. We reentered the well, ran an oil string, cemented it and have given it a fracture treatment. The well has never had an allowable on your proration sheet so will you please advise if information other than that given in this letter will be required in order to get an allowable assigned to this well.


We therefore request that this well be assigned the top allowable.
