Dear Sirs:

Barbara Fasken hereby requests exception to rule 303-A to permit the commingling in common facilities the commonly owned production from the Atoka and Strawn zones in the subject well.

The Strawn produces from perforations at 9847-9922'. The Atoka produces from perforations at 9988-10074'. A packer is set between the zones at 9946'. The Atoka is produced via tubing and the Strawn is producible via the casing. The current production rates are as follows:

<u>Zone</u>	<u>BOPD</u>	<u>Oil Gravity</u>	<u>MCFPD</u>
Strawn	0.2	51 deg API	45
Atoka	1.8	53 deg API	405

It is proposed that production be allocated to each zone as follows:

<u>Zone</u>	<u>Oil</u>	<u>Gas</u>
Strawn	10%	10%
Atoka	90%	90%

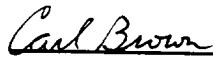
The commercial value of the commingled production will not be less than sum of the values from each source.

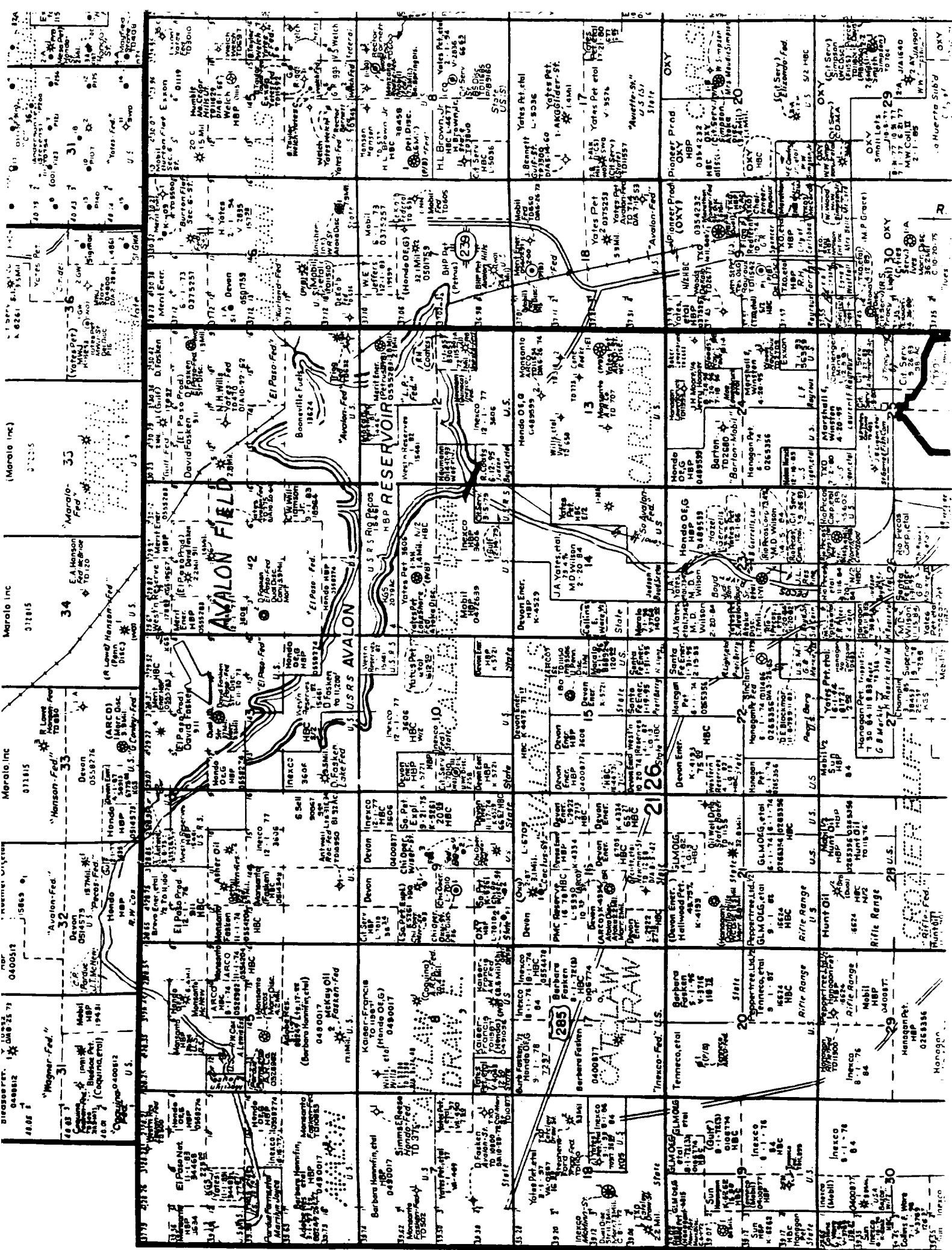

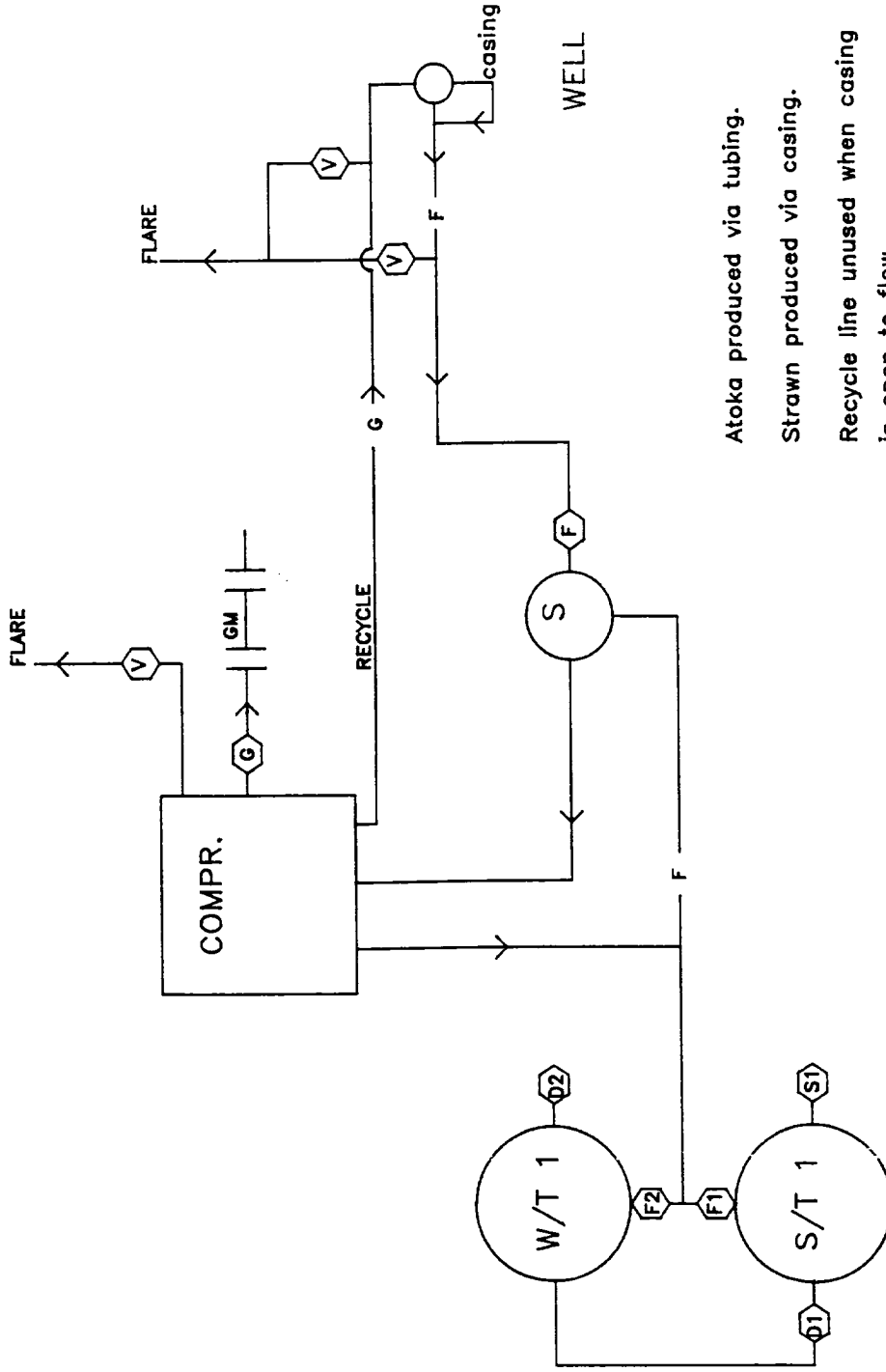
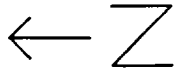
