 RIH w/ 4" casing gun loaded w/ 2 JSPF with 19 gram GOEX charges and perforate the following interval:  
 7610-16' (6', 12 holes)  
 Acidize w/ 200 gals 15% HCl acid with additives.  
 Frac with 2750 gals 30# XL + 12,000# 20/40 Resin Coated Sand.  
 Set CIBP @ 7100'. 6/25/97  
 RIH w/ 4" casing gun loaded w/ 2 JSPF @ 180 degree phased and perforate the following interval:  
 6849-52' (3', 6 holes)    6831-33' (2', 4 holes)    6770-72' (2', 4 holes)  
 Acidize w/ 1000 gals 7-1/2% HCl acid with additives  
 Frac with 12,382 gals 30# XL + 49,000# 20/40 Brady Sand + 13,000# 20/40 Resin Coated Sand.  
 Set CIBP @ 6750', test to 3000 psi, ok.  
 RIH w/ 4" casing gun loaded with 2 JSPF w/ 19 gram GOEX charges with 0 degree phased and perf the following interval:  
 6627-29' (2', 4 holes)    6300-04' (5', 10 holes)  
 Frac w/ 24,360 gals SFG-2500 + 140,000# sand.  
 Tag top of fill @ 6601'. Frac w/ 23,516 gals SFG-2500 + 50,890# sand.  
 Tag top of fill @ 6660'. Wash sand to PBD @ 6750'. Frac w/ 26,700 gals SFG-2500 + 152,000# 16/30 Resin Coated Sand.  
 Drill out CIBP's @ 6750', 7100' and 7892'. Clean up returns and return well to production.
