Dear Sirs:

**This second directive is to notify you that these wells are still in violation of OCD Rules.**

On January 13, 2004 an inspection was performed on the above well(s) and it was found the well(s) failed to meet mechanical integrity standards **and were required to be shut – in.** A review of our records indicates no correspondence has been received which indicates the well(s) have been brought into compliance. The well(s) must be **returned to physical compliance on or before the date indicated below.**

**In the event that a satisfactory response is not received to this letter of direction by May 24, 2004,** further enforcement will occur. Such enforcement may include this office applying to the Division for an order summoning you to a hearing before a Division Examiner in Santa Fe to show cause why you should not be ordered to permanently plug and abandon this well. Such a hearing may result in imposition of **CIVIL PENALTIES** for your violation of OCD rules.
