Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken. *


A backhoe struck a load line while clearing snow causing 70 bbls of produced water to leak onto the ground. No fluids were recovered and the line was repaired/replaced.

The affected area is approximately 35' x 30' on location inside the berm. Remediation was completed in accordance with the remediation plan approved by Mike Bratcher of NMOCD via email on 03/17/2016.
