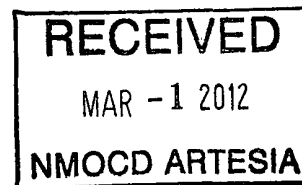

Dixie Electric finished construction of new secondary electrical pole lines to supply electricity to WHL #s 19, 20, 24 and 26 on February 3, 2012. These new lines were required due to the theft of ground electrical wire in October 2011. The new lines were set along existing roads and ROWs that had been approved by the BLM prior to construction. Approximately 5,900 feet of lines were required as opposed to the originally estimated 6,550 feet. Attached is a plat of the WHL showing existing wells, roads, ROWs, existing electrical pole lines and the newly constructed electrical pole lines.
